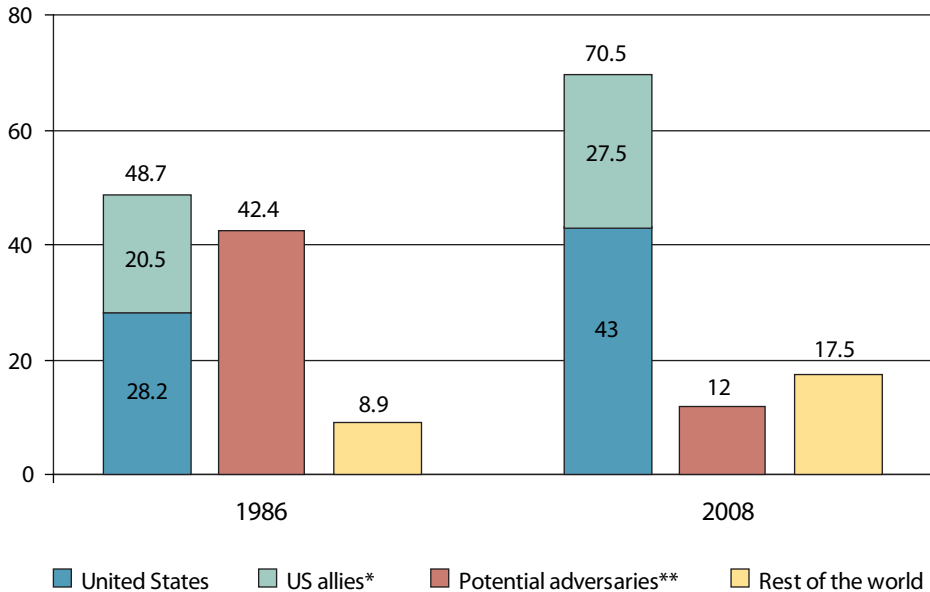


Percentage Shares Global Military Spending
